He has responded to 3 fallen officers in the area and helped with several others .The Tour is a 4 Day Ride starting NJ ending in Washington DC at the National memorial. Each of the 2600 riders (Officers and Survivors only)are required to raise funds to participate and they average \$2100 each. The event starts in early May. Their Chapter 13 group brought 175 riders this year. A slide show of the event showed the group how extensive the ride is.

The Club donated \$100 and members added another \$260 towards the event.
